Thank you for taking the time to access the online prize list for the **Bluegrass Festival Horse Show, the KHJA Horse Show and the USEF Junior Hunter Finals - East Coast.**

At this point in time we are hoping to proceed as scheduled with our shows. Entries and stall reservations both by mail and online are open. **PLEASE NOTE For a stall reservation to be accepted and processed, it must be accompanied by an actual horse entry. Tack stalls may be requested at 1 tack stall per 3 horses.** Entries and stall reservations may be secured online by credit card and by mail with a check. However, no credit cards will be charged and no checks deposited until we are certain that the shows can be held safely. At that time all entries will be considered definite entries and will become subject to the show policies regarding scratches as outlined in the prize list.

We are in the process of developing protocols to ensure the safety of everyone involved in the horse show environment once horse shows start again. These procedures will be arrived at with the guidance of state and local health authorities as well as USEF and when we have finalized them we will publish them. The driving force for all involved will be the health and safety of all exhibitors, their employees and show staff.

We will continue to monitor the Covid—19 situation and maintain communication with the Kentucky Horse Park, state and local health officials and USEF. Should we determine that the shows can't be held safely we will notify all affected parties immediately. In the meantime, we will distribute any updates by email and social media. ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday, July 22, 2020. Post Entries will be accepted until 4:00 PM the day before the class(es) are held at regular cost plus a one time late charge of \$50.00. Class declarations will be accepted until 4:00 PM the day before the class(es) are held. Should the need arise Management reserves the right to close entries to specific class(es) before the daily 4pm deadline. All horses entered must be named on the entry blank including horses shown only in equitation where the rider is being judged.

Entries may be submitted electronically using Show Management System On-Line Entry Platform, visit entries.showmanagementsystem.com. A nonrefundable 3% convenience fee will be assessed for all credit card charges.

Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner, rider or handler AND trainer. They must be accompanied by a check or credit card authorization for stabling fees. Post entries will be accepted as noted above, however, no stall will be reserved unless stall fees are paid by the closing of entries. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT BOTH SHOWS. ADDITIONALLY, AT THE BLUEGRASS FESTIVAL 75 STALLS WILL BE SET ASIDE FOR THOSE COMPETITORS WHO HAVE ENTERED THE USHJA INTERNATIONAL HUNTER DERBY FINALS AND 200 STALLS WILL BE SET ASIDE FOR THOSE COMPETITORS WHO HAVE ENTERED THE USHJA GREEN HUNTER INCENTIVE CHAMPIONSHIPS BY THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES(JULY 22). AT THE KHJA HORSE SHOW 290 STALLS WILL BE SET ASIDE FOR THOSE COMPETITORS WHO HAVE ENTERED THE USEF JUNIOR HUNTER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP BY THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES(JULY 22). ONCE THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED ADDITIONAL STABLING REQUESTS WILL BE PLACED ON A WAIT LIST AND THE AFFECTED EXHIBITORS WILL BE NOTIFIED. THE REMAINING AVAILABLE STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED ON A "FIRST COME—FIRST SERVED" BASIS.** Stalls may be reserved only by submission of completed entry forms along with payment. No reservations by telephone. Management reserves the right to charge a non-showing fee of \$100 to any horse not accumulating entry fees of \$100.

STABLING

Permanent stalls are of wood construction, 10 x 12 with doors and asphalt flooring. Temporary stalls of vinyl construction with asphalt flooring, 10 x 10 with doors and under canvas are available after supply of permanent stalls has been exhausted. The cost of stalls will be \$300.00 for each show except that horses competing only in the Junior Hunter Finals who arrive on August 22 will be subject to a stall fee of \$150

Early stabling (before 8:00 am Monday, August 10) or late stabling (after 8:00 am Monday, August 24) must be arranged for through the Stable Office and will be billed at \$50 per stall per day. Stable office (503) 510-8797. ANY STALLS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN VACATED BY 8 AM ON MONDAY, AUGUST 24 WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ASSESSED A \$50 PER DAY CHARGE BY THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK. THIS CHARGE WILL NOT BE WAIVED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES AND WILL BE BILLED THROUGH THE SHOW OFFICE.

Sharps containers will be located in the barn area. It is required to use the sharp containers for needles and disposable sharp instruments.

Passes must be obtained from the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center upon entry for a fee of **\$5.00 per day or \$15 per show**. Horse trailer passes are required for all competitors showing out of their trailers and must be purchased through the show office for **\$30 per show**. In addition, each horse will be assessed a **\$50 non stabling fee per show**. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot. **NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area.**

NIGHTWATCH

All horses occupying a stall, whether showing or not, are required to pay a one time per show nightwatch fee of \$15. This service is NOT OPTIONAL. Horses will be checked 6 times each night beginning at 7:00 pm on Monday, August 10 through 6:00 am Monday, August 24. Please provide emergency contact name and cell phone or hotel room and phone number at the stable office upon arrival.

ADMINISTRATION FEE

A nonrefundable administration fee of \$60.00 per horse will be charged.

AMBULANCE FEE

An ambulance fee of \$15 will be charged. This fee covers the cost of the medical personnel, an ambulance and the horse ambulance.

REFUNDS

No Stall Fees or Administration Fees will be refunded after closing date of entries.

A \$60 scratch fee will be assessed on all horses scratched after the closing date of entries. Stall fees and administration fees are nonrefundable. Once the shows have started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes entered. Proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office before the start of the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above the entry fees will be refunded less stall fee (if applicable), an administration fee of \$60 and scratch fee of \$60.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE

- A. Horses showing in classes in which they have not previously been entered will be required to pay a double entry fee for those classes.
- B. A processing fee of \$100.00 plus collection fees will be made for any nonnegotiable checks or declined credit cards.
- C. Non-showing horses will be assessed a fee of \$100.00 per week in addition to stabling charges.
- D. A \$50.00 non stabling fee will be charged to horses, whether showing or not, which are not being billed for a stall on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park.
- E. A release form must be obtained from the show office before any animals or equipment can be removed from the show grounds.
- F. Prize Money will be credited to each exhibitor's account. Any credit due will be mailed within 30 days following each show. No prize money will be mailed unless owner's (or other designated payee's) social security number and complete address are listed on the entry blank.

Some rings will be open August 11 and August 18. Hunter rings may be open for flat work each morning, weather permitting. Fees for schooling are included in the Administration Fee.

JUMP ORDER

A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

ALL HUNTERS

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in-and-out, oxers, post & rails, gate, aiken and panels.

In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Trophy and eight ribbons will be presented in each hunter class unless otherwise noted.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for one under saddle class.

Full Championship points will be given in all classes in each hunter section, unless otherwise noted.

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if number of entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. The Kentucky Summer Horse Shows, it's officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWS OR SHOW GROUNDS. Management reserves the right to change scheduled class locations or start times for any reason, inclement weather, time constraints or any other reason management decides is best for the horse's well being and competition.

CREDENTIALS

NO NUMBERS WILL BE RELEASED UNTIL PROPER CREDENTIALS AND ALL SIGNATURES ARE IN ORDER.

All exhibitors must have their current membership cards with them or a copy thereof, or send a copy of their card with their entry blank.

All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers will be released. All Pony or Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. **PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF MEASUREMENT CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.**

All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. **PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF AMATEUR CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.**

COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATES

Proof of negative Coggins Test within one year is required of every horse entering the Kentucky Horse Park. Out of state horses must be accompanied by a current Certificate of Veterinary inspection (within 30 days). Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are now required to be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary inspection within 150 days. This paperwork must accompany all horses on arrival. **Do not send with entries. SEE PAGE 7 FOR MORE INFORMATION.**

CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS

Campground reservations may not be made through the Horse Show office. To reserve a campsite at the Kentucky Horse Park for any of the horse shows, please call the Campground store at 800.370.6416 ext 4257 or (859) 259-4255 or email Ryan McGaughey at Ryan.mcgaughey@ky.gov. Be specific as to the show name and the dates you wish to stay. Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. and check-out is 12:00 noon. You must make arrangements with the Campground store if you plan to come earlier than 2:00 p.m. or stay later than 12:00 noon. Vehicles will be towed that are not removed from a campsite by check-out time.

KENTUCKY HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

1. **PARKING** – Passes must be obtained from the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center upon entry for a fee of **\$5.00 per day or \$15 per show**. Horse trailer passes are required for all competitors showing out of their trailers and must be purchased through the show office for **\$30 per show**. In addition, each horse will be assessed a **\$50 non stabling fee per show**. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot. **NO PARKING** is allowed in the barn area.
2. **CAMPER'S/R.V.'S/HORSE TRAILERS W/LIVING SPACE** – Must go to campground.
3. **GOLF CARTS/MOPEDS ETC.** – Please see page 7.
4. **DOGS** – Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animals/ animals left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
5. **HORSE'S AND HORSE DRAWN VEHICLES** – Have the right-of-way at all times.
6. **EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS** – All non-emergency problems or special requests *must* be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
7. **PACKAGES/DELIVERIES** – The Park is **not** responsible for any deliveries to an event or event participant. Receiving party must be present when delivery is expected. Please check with stable office for delivery address.
8. **PARK ADMISSION** – Reduced Horse Park admission is available to event participants and must be obtained at the Visitor Information Center.

KENTUCKY HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

9. ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

In compliance with the State of Kentucky Fire Code, the Kentucky Horse Park will no longer allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents. Non-complying equipment may be confiscated.

- a) **Any 2-prong plug appliances (fans, etc.)**
- b) **Any 2-prong plug extension cords**
- c) **Light duty cords for indoor use**
- d) **Any 3-way adaptors unless specifically for outdoor use**
- e) **Any adaptors without 3 prong connections**

10. MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Only the following vehicles are approved for use on Kentucky Horse Park property: golf carts, mopeds, JD Gators, Kawasaki Mules and similar utility vehicles (**NO 4 WHEELERS**). Electric scooters & motorbikes & scooters with engine displacement **50 cc or less**. Approved vehicles must not be operated in tourist areas of the Park & must be operated by a licensed driver at least 16 years old. All vehicles operated after dark must have a headlight & taillight. Use of unauthorized vehicles may result in a citation.

11. GOLF CARTS

- a) Exhibitors wishing to bring their private golf carts onto Kentucky Horse Park property must purchase a Golf Cart License.
- b) All drivers must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license.
- c) Golf carts are strictly prohibited in any tourist areas of the park.
- d) Golf carts must obey all traffic laws & posted speed limits and have working headlights.
- e) Golf carts can be rented through Cunninghams (859-233-7921).

IMPORTANT EQUINE HEALTH INFORMATION

The management of the Kentucky Horse Shows would like to make the following recommendations to all exhibitors who plan to travel to the Kentucky Horse Park for any events this year. Monitor our website at www.kentuckyhorseshows.com for any additional recommendations or requirements.

- 1. The state of Kentucky requires that all horses entering the state provide a negative Coggins test within one year of entry as well as a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of entry. Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within 150 days. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the grounds and the date of vaccination must be noted on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or documented by means noted in USEF GR845.
- 2. To facilitate the inspection process by Kentucky Department of Agriculture personnel upon arrival **this paperwork must accompany the horses** upon arrival and be available throughout their stay.
- 3. It is recommended that all horses arrive between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm. If it is absolutely necessary to arrive at any other time **you must** call the Stable Office at least 24 hours before arrival to make those arrangements. That telephone number is 503-510-8797.
- 4. Please take your horse's temperature on a regular basis so as to establish a normal temperature. If that temperature is elevated prior to shipping to Kentucky please consult your veterinarian as to the advisability of shipping that horse.
- 5. Immediately upon arrival please take your horse's temperature and if it is elevated consult a licensed veterinarian.
- 6. If your regular veterinarian is coming to the Kentucky Horse Park to treat your horse(s) he or she must register at the Stable office and receive guidelines for the reporting of any suspicious occurrences.
- 7. Please be conscious of the need to exercise good hygiene and vigilance in the day to day care of your animals.

- The Owner of record of the horse must be an Active member in good standing of the Federation and USHJA, i.e. horses must be shown in accordance with GR1102 and GR1108 in order to be eligible to qualify.
- Horses must have a valid microchip and current USEF measurement card.

SECTIONS

Both the 3'3" and 3'6" sections are divided into Small and Large Junior Hunters and again by age, riders 15 & Under and riders 16-17. The 3'3" section is open to any Junior rider and horse combination not entered in any 3'6" section.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to compete in the Adequan/USEF Junior Hunter National Championship, the horse must be recorded with the Federation and registered with USHJA on or before the first day of the competition. The owner must be an active member of the Federation and USHJA.

A maximum of 290 (120 3'6" and 170 3'3") horses will be accepted to compete, however USEF reserves the right to adjust this number to ensure fair and consistent point qualification standards and a safe competition environment. The number of entries accepted per section will be determined based on the current qualified numbers and past years' entries.

Entries for the Adequan/USEF Junior Hunter National Championships will be accepted based on the following:

- Spaces will first be filled with horses that qualified by winning a championship or reserve championship in an "A," "AA," "B," or "C" rated Junior Hunter 3'3" or 3'6" section between June 1, 2019, and May 31, 2020, OR being in the top-10 on each of the USHJA Junior Hunter Zone standings for competitions with a start date of December 1, 2019, through May 31, 2020. Horses that are champions in their respective sections at the previous year's USEF Junior Hunter National Championships may return without qualifying.
- If there are still open spaces, additional horses not otherwise qualified may be eligible to compete in the national championship based on National Horse of the Year (HOTY) points in their respective sections. These horses shall be accepted based on the National HOTY points earned by horses in their top 15 competitions starting on or after June 1, 2019, through competitions starting on or before May 31, 2020. Points from both the younger and older Junior Hunter sections shall be counted.

PHASES

The competition will be conducted in three separate phases:

Under Saddle: To count 20%. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Horses are to hand gallop one direction, halt and back. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability shall be emphasized.

Classic Round: To count 40%. The course must maintain at least ten obstacles, have two changes of direction, and at least one combination. There shall be one single oxer on the course that shall be ridden at the gallop. Emphasis shall be placed on "brilliance" for this round.

Handy Hunter: To count 40%. Obstacles should simulate those found in trappy hunt country. The course must have at least two changes of direction and at least one combination. Horses are required to trot over one fence on the course and may be asked to open a gate while mounted. Emphasis shall be places on "handiness" for this round.

SCORING

Under Saddle Phase: Horses shall be judged in groups of twelve or less. Each horse shall be judged and given a number score based on its performance.

Handy Hunter and Classic Round: Each entry will be given a numerical score based on its performance. In both the classic and handy round, exhibitors will be eliminated after two cumulative refusals.

MISCELLANEOUS

The same junior exhibitor is required to show an entry in all phases of the competition. Per HU124.3, exhibitors will be eliminated after two cumulative refusals.

Note: *If a horse/rider combination does not complete a phase or is eliminated from that phase, that horse will re-ceive a score of "0" for that phase but may continue on to compete in the remaining phases of the competition. A horse with a total score of "0" for a phase is not eligible for an award for that phase but is eligible for an overall award.*

JUDGING

All three judges will judge each phase simultaneously but independently of each other. Each judge will give every entry a score for each phase. Prior to the Under Saddle and Handy Hunter, each entry's score in the previous phase shall be totaled and announced. During the over fences phase, the Open Numerical Scoring System is used. After each entry completes the course each judge's score for the round is immediately shown or announced. The total overall score for each entry is then calculated as soon as it has completed the last phase.

TIES

Ties will be broken based on the score of the judge that is designated as judge number one for each phase of the competition. If a ties still exists for the overall standings, the score from the Classic Round will break such a tie.

COMPETITION SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Horses competing in the Adequan/USEF Junior Hunter National Championship are required to be stabled on the competition grounds beginning at 8:00 pm on Saturday, August 22 until that horse is finished competing in the Championship.

2. Commencing 12 hours prior to the start of the Championship and continuing until through competing, only the competition rider may ride his/her entry. These riders must wear their competition number at all times anywhere on the grounds while mounted.
3. The Official Schooling and Lungeing areas will be designated and locations posted in the Show Office. Participants are restricted to schooling and lungeing only in the Official Areas.
4. The use of illegal and/or dangerous jumps, equipment, bamboo offsets and poling is strictly prohibited.
5. Failure to comply with these rules will result in elimination if deemed appropriate by an appeals jury which will be composed of one of the competition's Federation Steward(s), a member of the Federation staff, and the competition manager.

QUALIFYING

The 'Gladstone Cup Equitation Classic' (formerly Hunterdon Cup Equitation Classic) may be held at either (or both) the East and West Coast USEF Junior Hunter National Championships. It is open to any Junior rider that has won either a US Hunter Seat Medal, ASPCA Maclay, USEF Show Jumping Talent Search either phase of a WIHS Equitation class at a National or Premier competition, or an Overall winner of a WIHS Equitation class at a competition with a start date between June 1 and May 31 of the qualifying year. Riders must be an active USHJA junior member at the time of competition in order to compete. Past winners of either the East or West USHJA Gladstone Cup Equitation Classic are no longer eligible to compete in either finals. Competitors in either the East or West USHJA Gladstone Cup Equitation Classic are no longer eligible to participate THIS Medal classes or Final.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Classic Phase: Riders to show over a classic hunter course of at least ten (10) jumps. Scores to be announced.

Handy Phase: Riders to show over a handy hunter course of at least ten (10) jumps. Handiness and brilliance to be emphasized. The top (20) riders will return for the Handy phase in reverse order based on the scores from Round 1. Scores to be announced.

Final Phase: Based on the combined scores from Rounds 1 and 2 a minimum of the top four (4) and a maximum of the top ten (10) riders will be asked to switch horses and jump a third course designed by the judges. The third course will use components of the course from Round 1 and/or 2 with a maximum of eight (8) jumps. The jumps may not be changed in any way from Phase 1 and/or 2, and the riders may not be asked to execute anything that they have not already executed on their own horse previously in this competition. Riders will switch as follows: riders one and two, riders three and four, riders five and six, et cetera. The riders will be asked to switch horses in either the show arena or a secured schooling area with the help of one assistant per rider. This assistant may not be the rider's trainer. A schooling supervisor will oversee the switching of horses and subsequent schooling. Once the riders have switched horses they will line up at the direction of the judges and the course will be announced. As their numbers are called, in reverse order (lower to higher combined scores from Phase 1 and Phase 2) the riders will be asked to do a brief flat, jump no more than two (2) schooling jumps and continue promptly to the final round course. No trainer assistance will be allowed once the finalists have been announced. Number scores will be given, but not announced until the final awards ceremony.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Jumps to be set at 3'6 with at least ten (10) hunter type jumps including a minimum of two (2) jumps with no ground lines. A variety of jumps that will nicely challenge the riders are encouraged.

Tack: Refer to EQ106.5a in the USEF Rule Book for current specifications.

Schooling: Commencing twelve (12) hours before the start of the USHJA Gladstone Cup Equitation Classic competition and continuing until finished competing

in the USHJA Gladstone Cup Equitation Classic, only the competition rider may ride his entry. These riders must wear their competition number whenever mounted. Riders may change horses for the Gladstone Cup only in the case of illness or injury to the declared horse, verification from the horse show veterinarian and approval from the horse show committee.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

Two judges will be selected by the USHJA for each of the USHJA Gladstone Cup Equitation Classics-East and West Coast. Both judges will sit together for the duration of the class and provide (1) numerical score for each competitor in each phase. Riders to be judged on style and smoothness with an emphasis on hunter style of riding. The scores from each phase will be combined for a final total score for each rider. The final combined scores from each rider will be used to determine placings. All ties will be broken using the scores from Phase 1.

AWARDS

The previous year's winner, if available, will be asked to assist in the presentation of the Top 10 ribbons. Ribbons will be awarded 1st-10th place with the presentation of awards to be given in reverse order. The Overall Champion will be presented keeper trophy. Recognition will be given to the Trainer of the Overall Champion. Recognition will be given for the Best Equitation Horse. To be awarded to the horse deemed by the judges to be the best and most suitable Equitation horse competing in the Gladstone Cup.

Draw reins and standing martingales are not permitted. All Developing Jumper classes will be held in accordance with JP116. Hind Boots: Non-weighted (maximum of 350 g) hind ankle boots are permitted in classes restricted to Five- and Six-year-olds. Support wraps are permitted. If boots are made of rigid leather or plastic, they may only be a maximum of 6 inches/15 cm in height.

In accordance with GR1111.4: Canada, IA, WI, MO, TN, VA, WV, PA, NJ are contiguous states.

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS: To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count. Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness. **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies. **ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections. Cross Entry: Riders entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation, Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Amateur Owner Hunter, Amateur Owner Jumper classes, and the USHJA International Hunter Derby). Riders competing in the Amateur Owner Hunter or Amateur Owner Jumper sections may compete on one different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Horses cannot cross enter into 3'3" or 3'6" Amateur Owner sections at the same competition. Horses may only compete in one age group per competition. **Fence Height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. Combinations will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** May be split into three sections when offered by age: Adult Amateurs 18–35 Adult Amateurs 36–49 Adult Amateurs 50 & over. Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

Under Saddle Classes: If an under saddle class is divided by age and a rider has two (2) or more horses entered, all riders must be amateurs but need not be eligible by age. **Handy Hunter Classes:** Handy Hunter Classes are optional and can be added at the competition management's discretion.

ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER: Sections offered and requirements: Low Adult Amateur Jumper, High Adult Amateur Jumper. **Cross Entry:** Low Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into High Amateur Owner classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.30m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money (including add back money) see HU141 and HU137 for cross entry restrictions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same competition. High Adult Amateur horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same competition. **Fence Height:** Low Adult Amateur Jumper 1.00m. High Adult Amateur Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (Children's with Adult Amateur sections) if so stated in the prize list.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE: Sections offered and requirements: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under. Children's Hunter Horse 15-17

Cross Entry: A Children's Hunter Horse rider may only compete one different horse in the Junior Hunter Sections. Riders entered in Children's Hunter Horse sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation classes up to 3'9", Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Junior Hunter sections and USHJA International Hunter Derby). A Junior Hunter rider may only compete one different horse in the Children's Hunter Horse section. Riders entered in the Children's Hunter Horse section may only compete on one Children's Hunter Pony at the same competition. Horses entered in Children's Hunter classes may not cross enter into Junior Hunter sections at the same competition. Horses may only compete in one age group per competition.

Fence Height: 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. Combinations will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. **Handy Hunter Classes:** Handy Classes are optional and can be added at the Competition Management's discretion.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY: Sections offered and requirements: Small/Medium Children's Pony. Large Children's Pony. Prize Money: No minimum prize money is required. **Cross Entry:** Riders competing in the Children's Hunter Pony section are not limited to the number of ponies they may show, providing they are not also competing in the Green or Regular Hunter Pony sections and/or Children's Hunter Horse section at the same competition (exception: competitions which limit entries in accordance with GR915). If a rider competing in the Children's Hunter Pony section chooses to compete in sections other than Children's Hunter Pony at the same competition, these riders are limited to competing a maximum of one (1) different pony in the Green or Regular Pony Hunter section and one (1) horse in the Children's Hunter horse section at the same competition and in any class not to exceed 3'5" (exception: Pony Jumpers). **Fence Height:** Small/Medium Ponies: 2'0" with spreads not to exceed height of fence. Large Ponies: 2'6" with spreads not to exceed height of fence. Combinations will not be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Children's Hunter Pony sections may be combined with Children's Hunter Horse sections if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. The Children's Hunter Pony may be divided by height (small/medium and large). If there are four (4) or more entries in each height section, the sections must be held separately. Suggested distances: At management's discretion, Children's Hunter Pony may choose to run the section as follows using the suggested distance guidelines: a. 2'0" Small Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on 9'9" stride): 4 strides at 48'9"; 5 strides at 58'6"; 6 strides at 68'3"; 7 strides at 78'8"; 8 strides at 87'9". b. 2'3" Medium Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on a 10'3" stride): 4 strides at 51'3"; 5 strides at 61'6"; 6 strides at 71'9"; 7 strides at 82'; 8 strides at 92'3". c. 2'6" Large Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on an 11' stride): 4 strides at 55'; 5 strides at 66'; 6 strides at 77'; 7 strides at 88'; 8 strides at 99'.

CHILDREN'S JUMPER: Sections offered and Requirements: Low Children's Jumper. High Children's Jumper. **Cross Entry:** Low Children's Jumpers riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. High Children's Jumper riders may not cross enter into High Junior classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.30m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money (including add back money) see HU141 and HU137 for cross entry restrictions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** Low Children's horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Children's Jumpers at the same competition. High Children's horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Children's Jumpers at the same competition. **Fence Height:** Low Children's Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m. High Children's Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (Children's with Adult Amateur sections) if so stated in the prize list.

UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION

"Every Class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current United States Equestrian rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith."

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE - GR1301.7 & 8

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
