Thank you for taking the time to access the online prize list for the **Kentucky Summer Horse Show** and the **Kentucky Summer Classic**, held over the two weeks beginning July 22nd and ending August 2nd.

At this point in time we are hoping to proceed as scheduled with our shows. Entries and stall reservations by mail are open immediately. The online entry platform will open on May 1st. Entries and stall reservations may be secured online by credit card and by mail with a check. However, no credit cards will be charged and no checks deposited until we are certain that the shows can be held safely. At that time all entries will be considered definite entries and will become subject to the show policy regarding scratches as outlined in the prize list.

We are in the process of developing protocols to ensure the safety of everyone involved in the horse show environment once horse shows start again. These procedures will be arrived at with the guidance of state and local health authorities as well as USEF and when we have finalized them we will publish them. The driving force for all involved will be the health and safety of all exhibitors, their employees and show staff.

We will continue to monitor the Covid—19 situation and maintain communication with the Kentucky Horse Park, state and local health officials and USEF. Should we determine that the shows can't be held safely we will notify all affected parties immediately. In the meantime, we will distribute any updates by email and social media. ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE Tuesday, June 23, 2020 for the Kentucky Summer Horse Show and Kentucky Summer Classic. Post Entries will be accepted until 4:00 PM the day before the class(es) are held at regular cost plus a one time late charge of \$50.00. Class declarations will be accepted until 4:00 PM the day before the class(es) are held. Should the need arise Management reserves the right to close entries to specific class(es) before the daily 4pm deadline. All horses entered must be named on the entry blank including horses shown only in equitation where the rider is being judged.

Entries may be submitted electronically using Show Management System On-Line Entry Platform, visit entries.showmanagementsystem.com. A nonrefundable 3% convenience fee will be assessed for all credit card charges.

Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner, rider or handler AND trainer. They must be accompanied by a check or credit card authorization for stabling fees. Post entries will be accepted as noted above, however, no stall will be reserved unless stall fees are paid by the closing of entries. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT BOTH SHOWS. ADDITIONALLY, AT THE KENTUCKY SUMMER CLASSIC 125 STALLS WILL BE SET ASIDE FOR THOSE COMPETITORS WHO HAVE ENTERED THE USHJA PONY HUNTER DERBY FINALS—EAST COAST BY THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES (JUNE 23). THE REMAINING AVAILABLE STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED ON A "FIRST COME—FIRST SERVED" BASIS. ONCE THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED ADDITIONAL STABLING REQUESTS WILL BE PLACED ON A WAIT LIST AND THE AFFECTED EXHIBITORS WILL BE NOTIFIED.** Stalls may be reserved only by submission of completed entry forms along with payment. No reservations by telephone. Management reserves the right to charge a non-showing fee of \$100 to any horse not accumulating entry fees of \$100.

STABLING

Permanent stalls are of wood construction, 10 x 12 with doors and asphalt flooring. Temporary stalls of vinyl construction with asphalt flooring, 10 x 10 with doors and under canvas are available after supply of permanent stalls has been exhausted. The cost of stalls will be \$300.00 for each show. **Early stabling (before 8:00 am Monday, July 20) or late stabling (after 8:00 am Monday, August 3) must be arranged for through the Stable Office and will be billed at \$50 per stall per day. Stable office (503) 510-8797. ANY STALLS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN VACATED BY 8 AM ON MONDAY, AUGUST 3 WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ASSESSED A \$50 PER DAY CHARGE BY THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK. THIS CHARGE WILL NOT BE WAIVED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES AND WILL BE BILLED THROUGH THE SHOW OFFICE.**

Sharps containers will be located in the barn area. It is required to use the sharp containers for needles and disposable sharp instruments.

Passes must be obtained from the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center upon entry for a fee of **\$5.00 per day or \$15 per show**. Horse trailer passes are required for all competitors showing out of their trailers and must be purchased through the show office for **\$30 per show**. In addition, each horse will be assessed a **\$50 non stabling fee per show**. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot. **NO PARKING** is allowed in the barn area.

NIGHTWATCH

All horses occupying a stall, whether showing or not, are required to pay a one time per show nightwatch fee of \$15. This service is NOT OPTIONAL. Horses will be checked 6 times each night beginning at 7 pm on Monday, July 20 through 6:00 am Monday, August 3. Please provide emergency contact name and cell phone or hotel room and phone number at the stable office upon arrival.

ADMINISTRATION FEE

A nonrefundable administration fee of \$60.00 per horse will be charged.

AMBULANCE FEE

An ambulance fee of \$15 will be charged. This fee covers the cost of the medical personnel, an ambulance and the horse ambulance.

REFUNDS

No Stall Fees or Administration Fees will be refunded after closing date of entries. A \$60 scratch fee will be assessed on all horses scratched after the closing date of entries. Stall fees and administration fees are nonrefundable. Once the shows have started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes entered. Proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office before the start of the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above the entry fees will be refunded less stall fee (if applicable), an administration fee of \$60 and scratch fee of \$60.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE

- A. Horses showing in classes in which they have not previously been entered will be required to pay a double entry fee for those classes.
- B. A processing fee of \$100.00 plus collection fees will be made for any nonnegotiable checks or declined credit cards.
- C. Non-showing horses will be assessed a fee of \$100.00 per week in addition to stabling charges.
- D. A \$50.00 non stabling fee will be charged to horses, whether showing or not, which are not being billed for a stall on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park.
- E. A release form must be obtained from the show office before any animals or equipment can be removed from the show grounds.
- F. Prize Money will be credited to each exhibitor's account. Any credit due will be mailed within 30 days following each show. No prize money will be mailed unless owner's (or other designated payee's) social security number and complete address are listed on the entry blank.

Some rings will be open July 21 and July 27. Hunter rings may be open for flat work each morning, weather permitting. Fees for schooling are included in the Administration Fee.

JUMP ORDER

A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

ALL HUNTERS

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in-and-out, oxers, post & rails, gate, aiken and panels.

In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Trophy and eight ribbons will be presented in each hunter class unless otherwise noted.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for one under saddle class.

Full Championship points will be given in all classes in each hunter section, unless otherwise noted.

MANAGEMENT

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. The Kentucky Summer Horse Shows, it's officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWS OR SHOW GROUNDS. Management reserves the right to change scheduled class locations or start times for any reason, inclement weather, time constraints or any other reason management decides is best for the horse's well being and competition.

CREENTIALS

NO NUMBERS WILL BE RELEASED UNTIL PROPER CREDENTIALS AND ALL SIGNATURES ARE IN ORDER.

All exhibitors must have their current membership cards with them or a copy thereof, or send a copy of their card with their entry blank.

All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers will be released. All Pony or Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. **PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF MEASUREMENT CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.**

All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. **PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF AMATEUR CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.**

COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATES

Proof of negative Coggins Test within one year is required of every horse entering the Kentucky Horse Park. Out of state horses must be accompanied by a current Certificate of Veterinary inspection (within 30 days). Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are now required to be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary inspection within 150 days. This paperwork must accompany all horses on arrival. **Do not send with entries. SEE PAGE 6 FOR MORE INFORMATION.**

CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS

Campground reservations may not be made through the Horse Show office.

To reserve a campsite at the Kentucky Horse Park for any of the horse shows, please call the Campground store at 800.370.6416 ext 4257 or (859) 259-4255 or email Ryan McGaughey at Ryan.mcgaughey@ky.gov. Be specific as to the show name and the dates you wish to stay. Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. and check-out is 12:00 noon. You must make arrangements with the Campground store if you plan to come earlier than 2:00 p.m. or stay later than 12:00 noon. Vehicles will be towed that are not removed from a campsite by check-out time.

KENTUCKY HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

1. **PARKING** – Passes must be obtained from the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center upon entry for a fee of **\$5.00 per day or \$15 per show**. Horse trailer passes are required for all competitors showing out of their trailers and must be purchased through the show office for **\$30 per show**. In addition, each horse will be assessed a **\$50 non stabling fee per show**. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot. **NO PARKING** is allowed in the barn area.
2. **CAMPER'S/R.V.'S/HORSE TRAILERS W/LIVING SPACE** – Must go to campground.
3. **GOLF CARTS/MOPEDS ETC.** – Please see page 6.
4. **DOGS** – Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animals/ animals left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
5. **HORSE'S AND HORSE DRAWN VEHICLES** – Have the right-of-way at all times.
6. **EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS** – All non-emergency problems or special requests *must* be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
7. **PACKAGES/DELIVERIES** – The Park is **not** responsible for any deliveries to an event or event participant. Receiving party must be present when delivery is expected. Please check with stable office for delivery address.
8. **PARK ADMISSION** – Reduced Horse Park admission is available to event participants and must be obtained at the Visitor Information Center.

KENTUCKY HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

9. ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

In compliance with the State of Kentucky Fire Code, the Kentucky Horse Park will no longer allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents. Non-complying equipment may be confiscated.

- a) **Any 2-prong plug appliances (fans, etc.)**
- b) **Any 2-prong plug extension cords**
- c) **Light duty cords for indoor use**
- d) **Any 3-way adaptors unless specifically for outdoor use**
- e) **Any adaptors without 3 prong connections**

10. MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Only the following vehicles are approved for use on Kentucky Horse Park property: golf carts, mopeds, JD Gators, Kawasaki Mules and similar utility vehicles (**NO 4 WHEELERS**). Electric scooters & motorbikes & scooters with engine displacement **50 cc or less**. Approved vehicles must not be operated in tourist areas of the Park & must be operated by a licensed driver at least 16 years old. All vehicles operated after dark must have a headlight & taillight. Use of unauthorized vehicles may result in a citation.

11. GOLF CARTS

- a) Exhibitors wishing to bring their private golf carts onto Kentucky Horse Park property must purchase a Golf Cart License.
- b) All drivers must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license.
- c) Golf carts are strictly prohibited in any tourist areas of the park.
- d) Golf carts must obey all traffic laws & posted speed limits and have working headlights.
- e) Golf carts can be rented through Cunninghams (859-233-7921).

IMPORTANT EQUINE HEALTH INFORMATION

The management of the Kentucky Horse Shows would like to make the following recommendations to all exhibitors who plan to travel to the Kentucky Horse Park for any events this year. Monitor our website at www.kentuckyhorseshows.com for any additional recommendations or requirements.

- 1. The state of Kentucky requires that all horses entering the state provide a negative Coggins test within one year of entry as well as a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of entry. Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within 150 days. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the grounds and the date of vaccination must be noted on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or documented by means noted in USEF GR845.
- 2. To facilitate the inspection process by Kentucky Department of Agriculture personnel upon arrival **this paperwork must accompany the horses** upon arrival and be available throughout their stay.
- 3. It is recommended that all horses arrive between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm. If it is absolutely necessary to arrive at any other time **you must** call the Stable Office at least 24 hours before arrival to make those arrangements. That telephone number is 503-510-8797.
- 4. Please take your horse's temperature on a regular basis so as to establish a normal temperature. If that temperature is elevated prior to shipping to Kentucky please consult your veterinarian as to the advisability of shipping that horse.
- 5. Immediately upon arrival please take your horse's temperature and if it is elevated consult a licensed veterinarian.
- 6. If your regular veterinarian is coming to the Kentucky Horse Park to treat your horse(s) he or she must register at the Stable office and receive guidelines for the reporting of any suspicious occurrences.
- 7. Please be conscious of the need to exercise good hygiene and vigilance in the day to day care of your animals.

The Green Hunter Incentive program is open to horses of any age that are eligible to compete as a green hunter 3', 3'3", 3'6" or 3'9" under Federation rules.

Qualifying and Eligibility

All ponies that have competed in at least one (1) USHJA Pony Hunter Derby at a licensed USEF competition within the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the USHJA Pony Hunter Derby Championship. The qualifying period for the East Coast USHJA Pony Hunter Derby Championship will be June 3, 2019 through May 29, 2020.

Rider age and pony size: See HU101.8 for current Federation Policy. Any rider under the age of 18 years may compete on any pony that is eligible for the Green Pony Hunter section provided that pony has been declared to earn HOTY points in the Green Pony Hunter section. A Green pony that competes in a USHJA Pony Hunter Derby Championship is no longer eligible for green reinstatement. Riders may compete on a total of two ponies but no more than one of any one size. Rider substitutions will not be allowed. If an East Coast and a West Coast Championship are offered, qualified ponies may only compete in one Championship.

Entries

Beginning in late May 2020 USHJA will send invitations to compete in the 2020 USHJA Pony Hunter Derby Championship to the recorded owners of each qualified pony. In order to compete entries must be submitted by mail or online by June 23, 2020. Entries may be on a first come, first served basis if scheduling constraints dictate. Show management may split the class by size if entries exceed 90 ponies.

Competition Format

1. The USHJA Pony Hunter Derby Championship will be composed of two (2) rounds: Classic Hunter Style Round and Handy Hunter Round. If required, a Jump-off Round will be held.
2. The PHD Championship Classic Hunter Style Round consists of the qualified and entered ponies present for this event. These ponies will compete over a Classic Hunter Course.
3. The PHD Championship Handy Hunter Round consists of a minimum of the top 12 ponies, including ponies tied for 12th, from the Classic Hunter Style Round. At the sole discretion of the USHJA, more than the top 12 ponies may be invited to return. These ponies will compete over a Handy Hunter Course.
4. The Classic Hunter Round order of go will be determined using random draw.
5. The Handy Hunter Round order of go will be determined by the scores from the Classic Hunter Round, with the lowest score returning first and highest score returning last within each height.
6. There will be a total of four judges. Judges will be seated separately in two panels consisting of two judges per panel. Both rounds shall be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance are to be rewarded. The two panels' scores will be announced separately and then averaged for a final average numerical score. The final average score of each pony-and-rider combination from the Classic Hunter Style and Handy Hunter Round will be added together to determine their final overall Pony Hunter Derby Championship placing.

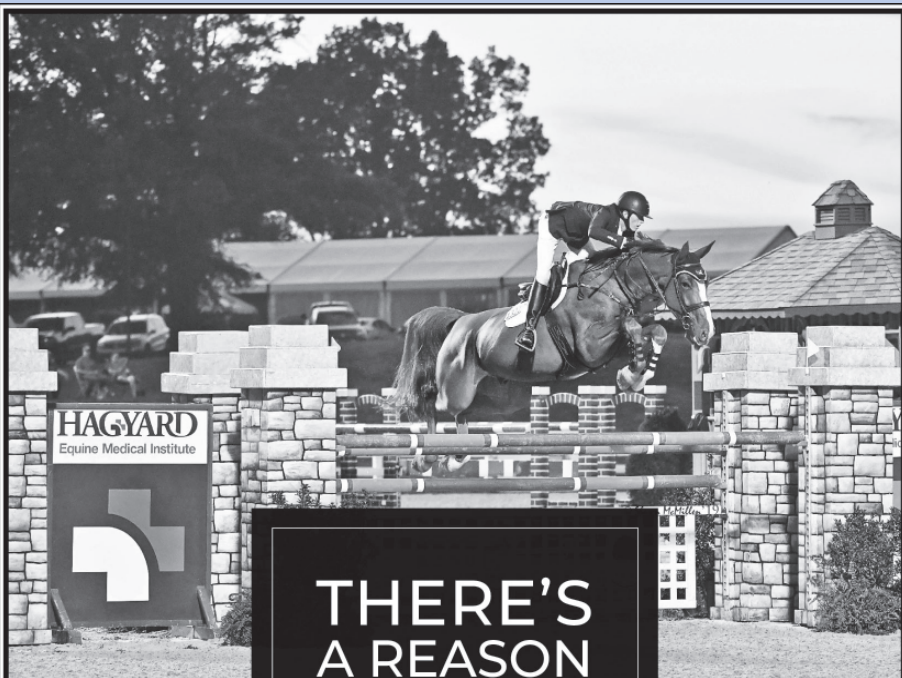

To be eligible for the Jumper Division, horses must be nominated and the nominating fee of \$225 paid by the closing date of entries June 23. Horses nominated after that date must pay a nominating fee of \$250. Nominated horses are eligible to compete in the Open, Amateur Owner/Junior, Children's and Adult Jumper Sections; as well as in all Grands Prix, Jumper Classics, and special jumper classes. In accordance with GR1111.4: Canada, IA, WI, MO, TN, VA, WV, PA, NJ are contiguous states.

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS: To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count. Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness. **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies. **ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections. Cross Entry: Riders entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation, Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Amateur Owner Hunter, Amateur Owner Jumper classes, and the USHJA International Hunter Derby). Riders competing in the Amateur Owner Hunter or Amateur Owner Jumper sections may compete on one different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Horses cannot cross enter into 3'3" or 3'6" Amateur Owner sections at the same competition. Horses may only compete in one age group per competition. **Fence Height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. Combinations will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** May be split into three sections when offered by age: Adult Amateurs 18-35 Adult Amateurs 36-49 Adult Amateurs 50 & over. Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. **Under Saddle Classes:** If an under saddle class is divided by age and a rider has two (2) or more horses entered, all riders must be amateurs but need not be eligible by age. **Handy Hunter Classes:** Handy Hunter Classes are optional and can be added at the competition management's discretion.

ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER: Sections offered and requirements: Low Adult Amateur Jumper, High Adult Amateur Jumper. **Cross Entry:** Low Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE: Sections offered and requirements: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under. Children's Hunter Horse 15-17 **Cross Entry:** A Children's Hunter Horse rider may only compete one different horse in the Junior Hunter Sections. Riders entered in Children's Hunter Horse sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation classes up to 3'9", Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Junior Hunter sections and USHJA International Hunter Derby). A Junior Hunter rider may only compete one different horse in the Children's Hunter Horse section. Riders entered in the Children's Hunter Horse section may only compete on one Children's Hunter Pony at the same competition. Horses entered in Children's Hunter classes may not cross enter into Junior Hunter sections at the same competition. Horses may only compete in one age group per competition.

Fence Height: 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. Combinations will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. **Handy Hunter Classes:** Handy Classes are optional and can be added at the Competition Management's discretion.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY: Sections offered and requirements: Small/Medium Children's Pony. Large Children's Pony. Prize Money: No minimum prize money is required. **Cross Entry:** Riders competing in the Children's Hunter Pony section are not limited to the number of ponies they may show, providing they are not also competing in the Green or Regular Hunter Pony sections and/or Children's Hunter Horse section at the same competition (exception: competitions which limit entries in accordance with GR915). Suggested Distances: At management's discretion, Children's Hunter Pony may choose to run the section as follows using the suggested distance guidelines: a. 2'0" Small Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on 9'9" stride): 4 strides at 48'9"; 5 strides at 58'6"; 6 strides at 68'3"; 7 strides at 78'8"; 8 strides at 87'9". b. 2'3" Medium Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on a 10'3" stride): 4 strides at 51'3"; 5 strides at 61'6"; 6 strides at 71'9"; 7 strides at 82'; 8 strides at 92'3". c. 2'6" Large Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on an 11' stride): 4 strides at 55'; 5 strides at 66'; 6 strides at 77'; 7 strides at 88'; 8 strides at 99'.

CHILDREN'S JUMPER: Sections offered and Requirements: Low Children's Jumper. High Children's Jumper. **Cross Entry:** Low Children's Jumpers riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. High Children's Jumper riders may not cross enter into High Junior classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.50m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money (including add back money) see HU141 and HU137 for cross entry restrictions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** Low Children's horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Children's Jumpers at the same competition. High Children's horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Children's Jumpers at the same competition. **Fence Height:** Low Children's Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m. High Children's Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (Children's with Adult Amateur sections) if so stated in the prize list.

UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION

"Every Class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current United States Equestrian rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith."

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE - GR1301.7 & 8

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule

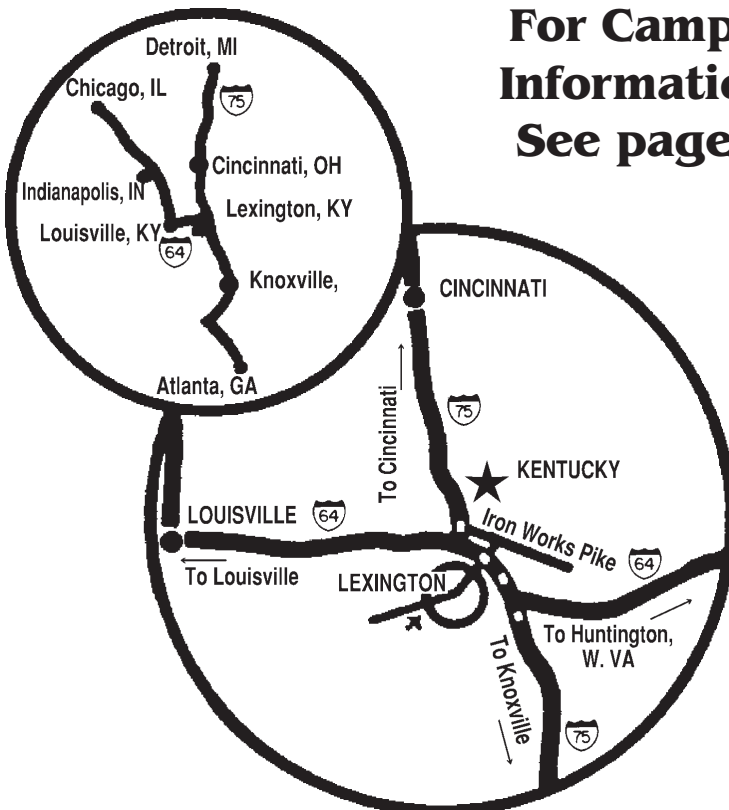
