ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE TUESDAY, APRIL 13, 2021. Post Entries will be accepted until **4:00 PM** the day before the class(es) are held at regular cost plus a one time late charge of \$50.00. Class declarations will be accepted until **4:00 PM** the day before the class(es) are held. All horses entered must be named on the entry blank including horses shown only in equitation where the rider is being judged.

Entries may be submitted electronically using Show Management System On-Line Entry Platform, visit entries.showmanagementsystem.com. A 3% nonrefundableconvenience fee will be assessed for all credit card charges.

Entry blanks will be accepted **ONLY** when signed by the owner, rider or handler **AND** trainer. They must be accompanied by payment for stabling fees. Post entries will be accepted as noted above, however, **NO STALL WILL BE RESERVED UNLESS STALL FEES ARE PAID BY THE CLOSING OF ENTRIES. PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT BOTH SHOWS. STALLS MAY BE RESERVED ONLY BY SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH PAYMENT. NO RESERVATIONS BY TELEPHONE.** MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHARGE A NON-SHOWING FEE OF \$ 100 TO ANY HORSE NOT ACCUMULATING ENTRY FEES OF \$ 100.

STABLING

Permanent stalls are of wood construction, 10 x 12 with doors and asphalt flooring. Temporary stalls of vinyl construction with asphalt flooring, 10 x 10 with doors and under canvas are available after supply of permanent stalls has been exhausted. The cost of stalls will be \$300 for each show. Tack stalls in the FEI stabling compound will be \$400. PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT BOTH SHOWS. STALLS MAY BE RESERVED ONLY BY SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH PAYMENT. STALLS MAY NOT BE RESERVED BY TELEPHONE. STALLS REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF THE KENTUCKY SPRING HORSE SHOWS AND MAY NOT BE SOLD BY EXHIBITORS WITHOUT THE EXPRESS CONSENT OF SHOW MANAGEMENT.

Stalls will be available at 8:00 A.M. on Monday, May 10. If you plan to arrive earlier you **must** call ahead so that arrangements can be made. Stable office (503) 510-8797. **Early stabling (before 8:00 am Monday, May 10) or late stabling (after 8:00 am Monday, May 24) must be arranged for through the Stable Office and will be billed at \$50 per stall per day (horse and tack stalls). ANY STALLS (HORSE AND TACK STALLS) THAT HAVE NOT BEEN VACATED BY 8 AM ON MONDAY, MAY 24 WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ASSESSED A \$50 PER DAY CHARGE BY THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK. THIS CHARGE WILL NOT BE WAIVED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES AND WILL BE BILLED THROUGH THE SHOW OFFICE.**

Sharps containers will be located in the barn area. It is required to use the sharp containers for needles and disposable sharp instruments.

Passes must be obtained from the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center upon entry for a fee of \$5.00 per day or \$15 per show or \$50 for the season. Any horses, whether showing or not, who do not purchase a stall will be assessed a \$50 non stabling fee per show. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot. **NO PARKING** is allowed in the barn area.

NIGHTWATCH

All horses occupying a stall, whether showing or not, are required to pay a one time per show nightwatch fee of \$15 per show. This service is NOT OPTIONAL. Horses will be checked 6 times each night beginning at 7 pm on Monday, May 10 through 6:00 am Monday, May 24. Please provide emergency contact name and cell phone or hotel room and phone number at the stable office upon arrival.

REFUNDS

No Stall Fees or Administration Fees will be refunded after closing date of entries. A \$60 scratch fee will be assessed on all horses scratched after the closing date of entries. Stall fees and administration fees are nonrefundable. Once the shows have started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes entered. Proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office before the start of the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above the class entry fees will be refunded. Stall fees (if applicable), an administration fee of \$60 and a scratch fee of \$60 will be charged.

CREDENTIALS

NO NUMBERS WILL BE RELEASED UNTIL PROPER CREDENTIALS AND ALL SIGNATURES ARE IN ORDER. All exhibitors must have their current membership cards with them or a copy thereof, or send a copy of their card with their entry blank.

All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers will be released. All Pony or Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. **PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF MEASUREMENT CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.**

All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. **PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF AMATEUR CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.**

All horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete. Horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete. Exceptions: USHJA Outreach and those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9.

ADMINISTRATION FEE

An administration fee of \$60.00 per horse will be charged.

AMBULANCE FEE

An ambulance fee of \$15 will be charged. This fee covers the cost of the medical personnel, an ambulance and the horse ambulance and personnel.

COVID FEE

A COVID compliance fee of \$30 will be charged. This fee covers the cost of personnel and equipment required to ensure compliance with COVID-19 protocols.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE

- A. Horses showing in classes in which they have not previously been entered will be required to pay a double entry fee for those classes.
- B. A processing fee of \$100.00 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable checks or declined credit card payments.
- C. Non-showing horses will be assessed a fee of \$100.00 per week in addition to stabling charges.
- D. A \$50.00 non stabling fee will be charged to horses, whether showing or not, which are not being billed for a stall on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park.
- E. A release form must be obtained from the show office before any animals or equipment can be removed from the show grounds.
- F. Prize Money will be credited to each exhibitor's account. Any credit due will be mailed within 30 days following each show. No prize money will be mailed unless owner's (or other designated payee's) social security number and complete address are listed on the entry blank.

SCHOOLING

The hunter rings will be open Tuesday, May 11 and May 18. Hunter rings may be open for flat work each morning, weather permitting. Fees for schooling are included in the Administration Fee.

MANAGEMENT

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. The Kentucky Spring Horse Shows, it's officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWS OR SHOW GROUNDS. Management reserves the right to change scheduled class locations or start times for any reason, inclement weather, time constraints or any other reason management decides is best for the horses well being and competition.

COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATES

Proof of negative Coggins Test within one year is required of every horse entering the Kentucky Horse Park. Out of state horses must be accompanied by a current Certificate of Veterinary inspection (within 30 days). Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are now required to be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary inspection within 150 days. This paperwork must accompany all horses on arrival. **Do not send with entries. SEE PAGE 7 FOR MORE INFORMATION ON USEF VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS.**

ALL HUNTERS

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in-and-out, oxers, post & rails, gate, aiken and panels.

In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Trophy and eight ribbons will be presented in each hunter class unless otherwise noted.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for one under saddle class. Full Championship points will be given in all classes in each hunter section, unless otherwise noted.

HUNTER RING INFORMATION

Stonelea: 140 x 280' Fine Sand and GGT fibre on pvc mats.

Stonelea/ Murphy Schooling: 112' x 420' Fine Sand and GGT fibre on pvc mats

Murphy: 135' x 280' Fine Sand and GGT fibre on pvc mats. **Claiborne:** 140' x 270' Fine Sand and GGT fibre on pvc mats.

Annex: 130' x 250' Sand cushion on limestone base

Covered Arena: 145' x 285' Sand cushion on limestone base

POLING

Manual Poling and the use of Offsets are prohibited at all times on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park. In the event of a violation of this regulation, the involved horse and it's trainer of record as indicated on the entry blank may be suspended from further competition at the show at which the violation occurred.

JUMP ORDER

A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

- 1. PARKING Passes must be obtained from the Parking Booth or Visitor Information Center upon entry for a fee of \$5.00 per day or \$15 per show. Horse trailer passes are required for all competitors showing out of their trailers and must be purchased through the show office for \$30 per show. In addition, each horse will be assessed a \$50 non stabling fee per show. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area.
- 2. CAMPER'S/ R.V.'S/ HORSE TRAILERS W/LIVING SPACE Must go to campground.
- **3. GOLF CARTS/ MOPEDS ETC. -** Please see page 7.
- **DOGS** Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animals/animals left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
- **5.** HORSES AND HORSE DRAWN VEHICLES Have the right-of-way at all times.
- **6. EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS**—All non-emergency problems or special requests *must* be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
- **7. PACKAGES/DELIVERIES** The Park is **not** responsible for any deliveries to an event or event participant. Receiving party must be present when delivery is expected. Please check with stable office for delivery address.
- **8. PARK ADMISSION** Reduced Horse Park admission is available to event participants and must be obtained at the Visitor Information Center.

CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS

Campground reservations may not be made through the Horse Show office.

To reserve a campsite at the Kentucky Horse Park for any of the horse shows, please call the Campground store at 800.370.6416 ext 4257 or (859) 259-4255 or email Ryan McGaughey at <u>Ryan.mcgaughey@ky.gov</u>. Be specific as to the show name and the dates you wish to stay. Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. and check-out is 12:00 noon. You must make arrangements with the Campground store if you plan to come earlier than 2:00 p.m. or stay later than 12:00 noon. Vehicles will be towed that are not removed from a campsite by check-out time.

IMPORTANT EQUINE HEALTH INFORMATION

The management of the Kentucky Spring Horse Shows would like to make the following recommendations to all exhibitors who plan to travel to the Kentucky Horse Park for any events this year. Monitor our website at www.kentuckyhorseshows.com for any additional recommendations or requirements.

- 1. The state of Kentucky requires that all horses entering the state provide a negative Coggins test within one year of entry as well as a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of entry. Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within 150 days. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the grounds and the date of vaccination must be noted on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or documented by means noted in USEF GR845.
- 2. To facilitate the inspection process by Kentucky Department of Agriculture personnel, upon arrival *this paperwork must accompany the horses* upon arrival and be available throughout their stay.
- 3. It is recommended that all horses arrive between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm. If it is absolutely necessary to arrive at any other time *you must* call the Stable Office at least 24 hours before arrival to make those arrangements. That telephone number is (503) 510-8797.
- 4. Please take your horse's temperature on a regular basis so as to establish a normal temperature. If that temperature is elevated prior to shipping to Kentucky please consult your veterinarian as to the advisability of shipping that horse.
- 5. Immediately upon arrival please take your horse's temperature and if it is elevated consult a licensed veterinarian.
- 6. If your regular veterinarian is coming to the Kentucky Horse Park to treat your horse(s) he or she must register at the Stable office and receive guidelines for the reporting of any suspicious occurrences.
- 7. Please be conscious of the need to exercise good hygiene and vigilance in the day to day care of your animals.

KENTUCKY HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

1. ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

In compliance with the State of Kentucky Fire Code, the Kentucky Horse Park will no longer allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents. Non-complying equipment may be confiscated.

- a) any 2 prong plug appliances (fans, etc.)
- b) any 2 prong plug extension cords
- c) light duty cords for indoor use
- d) any 3-way adaptors unless specifically for outdoor use
- e) any adaptors without 3 prong connections

2. MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Only the following vehicles are approved for use on Kentucky Horse Park property: golf carts, mopeds, JD Gators, Kawasaki Mules and similar utility vehicles (**NO 4-WHEELERS**). Electric scooters & motorbikes & scooters with engine displacement **50 cc or less**. Approved vehicles must not be operated in tourist areas of the Park & must be operated by a licensed driver at least 16 years old. All vehicles operated after dark must have a headlight & taillight. Use of unauthorized vehicles may result in a citation.

3. GOLF CARTS

- a) Exhibitors wishing to bring their private golf carts onto Kentucky Horse Park property must purchase a **Golf Cart License**.
- b) All drivers must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license.
- c) Golf carts are strictly prohibited in any tourist areas of the park.
- d) Golf carts must obey all traffic laws & posted speed limits and have working headlights.
- e) Golf carts can be rented through Cunningham's (859-233-7921).



Jump Off: In the case of a tie for first place, the horses and riders involved will be asked to perform another round over a course with a minimum of 8 obstacles. Fence height 3'6"-4'0", exception option fences. There will be four high option jumps in the course set at 4'3". The course should simulate riding over hunt country & must include a minimum of 2 handy options, such as: tight turn options, different track options, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 3", execute a walk fence while mounted not to exceed 12" in height, halt and/or back. Leading over an obstacle and opening or closing a gate, mounted or not, are not permitted. Gimmicky options are not appropriate.

Obstacle Requirements (All Rounds): Obstacles must simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and the course must offer a variety of Derby jumps with different appearances such as: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs, natural foliage. Natural obstacles such as banks and ditches are allowed. A minimum 2" difference is required for the back element of an obstacle. Ground lines are not to exceed 18" in depth from the vertical plane of the jump. For appropriate jumps, no ground line is required. The jumpable portion of any obstacle must be a minimum of 8 feet on its front face. Flat cups may only be used for obstacles involving logs and/or in accordance with Federation rules.

Stabling Jog: All horses entered in the International Hunter Derby class must be on the grounds 24 hours prior to the start of the first round in order to compete. Any horse that leaves the premises prior to completing its participation in the Derby class is disqualified.

Tie Breaking Procedures: There will be 2 judging panels of 2 judges each. Class Specifications: Riders are limited to competing no more than four horses in each class. 

Horses and Ponies are not required to jog forsoundness. **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open tohorses and ponies. **ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections. Cross Entry:Riders entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation, Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Amateur Owner Hunter, Amateur Owner Jumper classes, and the USHJA International Hunter Derby). Riders competing in the Amateur Owner Hunter or Amateur Owner Jumper sections may compete on one different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Horses cannot cross enter into 3'3" or 3'6"Amateur Owner sections at the same competition. Horses may only compete in one age group per competition. **Fence Height:**3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. •Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. Combinations will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** May be split into three sections when offered by age: Adult Amateurs 18–35 Adult Amateurs 36–49 Adult Amateurs 50 & over. Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. A non-member may participate as ahandler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee.Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3)games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9)citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE – GR1301.7

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule






