Thank you for taking the time to access the online prize list for the Kentucky Spring Horse Show and the Kentucky Spring Classic, held over the two weeks beginning May 7th and ending May 19th.

Entries and stall reservations may be secured online by credit card and by mail with a check. The online entry platform will open on **MONDAY, MARCH 4, 2024**. Stalls will be reserved only by submission of a horse entry form and payment of a deposit in the amount of \$ 525.30.

USEF-Licensed competitions must operate in accordance with state and local requirements for COVID-19, if in place. In the absence of state or local requirements, USEF recommends compliance with CDC guidelines. In an effort to mitigate the risk of spreading COVID-19, Competition Organizers may impose more restrictive requirements if they so choose.

A separate USEF WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT must be completed by every exhibitor competing at the Kentucky Spring Horse Shows. Those of you using the online entry platform will be required to sign a USEF WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT as part of the entry process. The Waiver form will also be available on www.kentuckyhorseshows.com.

ENTRIES MAY BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY

The 2024 Kentucky Horse Shows will use the Show Management System™ On-Line Entry Platform to accept electronic entries for the competitions. This service is billed as part of your office fee and we encourage you to use the Show Management System platform. ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE TUESDAY, APRIL 16, 2024. Post Entries will be accepted until **4:00 PM** the day before the class(es) are held at regular cost plus a one time late charge of \$50.00. Class declarations will be accepted until **4:00 PM** the day before the class(es) are held. All horses entered must be named on the entry blank including horses shown only in equitation where the rider is being judged.

Entries may be submitted electronically using Show Management System On-Line Entry Platform, visit entries.showmanagementsystem.com. A 3% nonrefundable convenience fee will be assessed for all credit card charges.

Entry blanks will be accepted **ONLY** when signed by the owner, rider or handler **AND** trainer. They must be accompanied by payment for stabling fees. Post entries will be accepted as noted above, however, **NO STALL WILL BE RESERVED UNLESS STALL FEES ARE PAID BY THE CLOSING OF ENTRIES. PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT BOTH SHOWS. STALLS MAY BE RESERVED ONLY BY SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH PAYMENT. NO RESERVATIONS BY TELEPHONE. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHARGE A NON-SHOWING FEE OF \$100 TO ANY HORSE NOT ACCUMULATING ENTRY FEES OF \$100.**

STABLING

Permanent stalls are of wood construction, 10 x 12 with doors and asphalt flooring. Temporary stalls of vinyl construction with asphalt flooring, 10 x 10 with doors and under canvas are available after supply of permanent stalls has been exhausted. The cost of stalls will be \$350 for each show. Tack stalls in the FEI stabling compound will be \$400. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT BOTH SHOWS. STALLS MAY BE RESERVED ONLY BY SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH PAYMENT. STALLS MAY NOT BE RESERVED BY TELEPHONE. STALLS REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF THE KENTUCKY SPRING HORSE SHOWS AND MAY NOT BE SOLD BY EXHIBITORS WITHOUT THE EXPRESS CONSENT OF SHOW MANAGEMENT.**

Stalls will be available at 8:00 A.M. on Monday, May 6. If you plan to arrive earlier you **must** call ahead so that arrangements can be made. Stable office (503) 510-8797. **Early stabling (before 8:00 am Monday, May 6) or late stabling (after 8:00 am Monday, May 20) must be arranged for through the Stable Office and will be billed at \$50 per stall per day (horse and tack stalls). ANY STALLS (HORSE AND TACK STALLS) THAT HAVE NOT BEEN VACATED BY 8 AM ON MONDAY, MAY 20 WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ASSESSED A \$50 PER DAY CHARGE BY THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK. THIS CHARGE WILL NOT BE WAIVED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES AND WILL BE BILLED THROUGH THE SHOW OFFICE.**

Sharps containers will be located in the barn area. It is required to use the sharp containers for needles and disposable sharp instruments.

Any horses, whether showing or not, who do not purchase a stall will be assessed a **\$50 non stabling fee per show**. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot. **NO PARKING** is allowed in the barn area.

NIGHTWATCH

All horses occupying a stall, whether showing or not, are required to pay a one time per show nightwatch fee of \$20 per show. This service is **NOT OPTIONAL**. Horses will be checked 6 times each night beginning at 7 pm on Monday, May 6 through 6:00 am Monday, May 20. Please provide emergency contact name and cell phone or hotel room and phone number at the stable office upon arrival.

REFUNDS

No Stall Fees or Administration Fees will be refunded after closing date of entries. A \$85 scratch fee will be assessed on all horses scratched after the closing date of entries. Stall fees and administration fees are nonrefundable. Once the shows have started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes entered. Proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office before the start of the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above the class entry fees will be refunded. Stall fees (if applicable), an administration fee of \$75 and a scratch fee of \$85 will be charged.

ADMINISTRATION FEE

A nonrefundable administration fee of \$75.00 per horse will be charged.

AMBULANCE FEE

An ambulance fee of \$35 will be charged. This fee helps to defray the cost of the medical personnel, an ambulance and the horse ambulance and personnel.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE

- A. Horses showing in classes in which they have not previously been entered will be required to pay a double entry fee for those classes.
- B. A processing fee of \$100.00 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable checks or declined credit card payments.
- C. Non-showing horses will be assessed a fee of \$100.00 per week in addition to stabling charges.
- D. A \$50.00 non stabling fee will be charged to horses, whether showing or not, which are not being billed for a stall on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park.
- E. Prize Money will be credited to each exhibitor's account. Any credit due will be mailed within 30 days following each show. No prize money will be mailed unless owner's (or other designated payee's) social security number and complete address are listed on the entry blank.

MANAGEMENT

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. The Kentucky Spring Horse Shows, its officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWS OR SHOW GROUNDS. Management reserves the right to change scheduled class locations or start times for any reason, inclement weather, time constraints or any other reason management decides is best for the horses well being and competition.

POLING

Manual Poling and the use of Offsets are prohibited at all times on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park. In the event of a violation of this regulation, the involved horse and it's trainer of record as indicated on the entry blank may be suspended from further competition at the show at which the violation occurred.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

Per USEF Rule GR801.2: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

JUMP ORDER

A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

SAFE SPORT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. KENTUCKY HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

1. **PARKING** – Free parking will be provided compliments of Kentucky Horse Shows. A \$ 50.00 non stabling fee will be charged to horses , whether showing or not, which are not being billed for a stall on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park. Day trailers must park in the designated lot. ***NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area.***
2. **CAMPER'S/ R.V.'S/ HORSE TRAILERS W/LIVING SPACE** – Must go to campground.
3. **DOGS** – Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animals/animals left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
4. **HORSES AND HORSE DRAWN VEHICLES** – Have the right-of-way at all times.
5. **PACKAGES/DELIVERIES** – The Park is **not** responsible for any deliveries to an event or event participant. Receiving party must be present when delivery is expected. Please check with stable office for delivery address.
6. **PARK ADMISSION** – Reduced Horse Park admission is available to event participants and must be obtained at the Visitor Information Center.
7. **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT**

In compliance with the State of Kentucky Fire Code, the Kentucky Horse Park will no longer allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents. Non-complying equipment may be confiscated.

- a) any 2 prong plug appliances (fans, etc.)
- b) any 2 prong plug extension cords
- c) light duty cords for indoor use
- d) any 3-way adaptors unless specifically for outdoor use
- e) any adaptors without 3 prong connections

8. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES**

Only the following vehicles are approved for use on Kentucky Horse Park property: golf carts, mopeds, JD Gators, Kawasaki Mules and similar utility vehicles (**NO 4-WHEELERS**). Electric scooters & motorbikes & scooters with engine displacement **50 cc or less**. Approved vehicles must not be operated in tourist areas of the Park & must be operated by a licensed driver at least 16 years old. All vehicles operated after dark must have a headlight & taillight. Use of unauthorized vehicles may result in a citation.

9. **GOLF CARTS**

- a) All drivers must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license.
- b) Golf carts are strictly prohibited in any tourist areas of the park.
- c) Golf carts must obey all traffic laws & posted speed limits and have working headlights.
- d) Golf carts can be rented through Dever Inc. (859) 233-9702.

IMPORTANT EQUINE HEALTH INFORMATION

The management of the Kentucky Spring Horse Shows would like to make the following requirements to all exhibitors who plan to travel to the Kentucky Horse Park for any events this year. Monitor our website at www.kentuckyhorseshow.com for any additional recommendations or requirements.

1. The state of Kentucky requires that all horses entering the state provide a negative Coggins test within one year of entry as well as a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of entry. Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within 150 days. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the grounds and the date of vaccination must be noted on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or documented by means noted in USEF GR844.
2. To facilitate the inspection process by Kentucky Department of Agriculture personnel, **this paperwork must accompany the horses** upon arrival and be available throughout their stay. This paperwork must also be presented at the show office in order to pick up numbers.
3. It is recommended that all horses arrive between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm. If it is absolutely necessary to arrive at any other time **you must** call the Stable Office at least 24 hours before arrival to make those arrangements. That telephone number is (503) 510-8797.
4. Please take your horse's temperature on a regular basis so as to establish a normal temperature. If that temperature is elevated prior to shipping to Kentucky please consult your veterinarian as to the advisability of shipping that horse.
5. Immediately upon arrival please take your horse's temperature and if it is elevated consult a licensed veterinarian.
6. If your regular veterinarian is coming to the Kentucky Horse Park to treat your horse(s) he or she must register at the Stable office and receive guidelines for the reporting of any suspicious occurrences.
7. Please be conscious of the need to exercise good hygiene and vigilance in the day to day care of your animals.

CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS

Campground reservations may not be made through the Horse Show office.

To reserve a campsite at the Kentucky Horse Park for any of the horse shows, please call the Campground store at (859) 259-4257, press option 2 for camp ground or email khpcampground@ky.gov. Be specific as to the show name and the dates you wish to stay. Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. and check-out is 12:00 noon. You must make arrangements with the Campground store if you plan to come earlier than 2:00 p.m. or stay later than 12:00 noon. Vehicles will be towed that are not removed from a campsite by check-out time.

ALL HUNTERS

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in-and-out, oxers, post & rails, gate, aiken and panels.

All Hunter Classes are held in accordance with USEF HU118 Option A jogging for soundness: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance.

In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Trophy and eight ribbons will be presented in each hunter class unless otherwise noted.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for one under saddle class. Full Championship points will be given in all classes in each hunter section, unless otherwise noted.

Leading over an obstacle and opening and/or closing a gate(s), mounted or not, is not permitted. Gimmicky options are not appropriate. Only the top 12 entries, after all first round ties are broken, will be eligible to return for Round 2, if available.

Jump Off: In the case of a tie for first place, the horses and riders involved will be asked to perform another round over a course with a minimum of 8 obstacles. Fence height 3'6"-4'0", exception option fences. There will be four high option jumps in the course set at a minimum of 4'. The course should simulate riding over hunt country & must include a minimum of 2 handy options, such as: tight turn options, different track options, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 3', execute a walk fence while mounted not to exceed 12" in height, halt and/or back. Leading over an obstacle and opening or closing a gate, mounted or not, are not permitted. Gimmicky options are not appropriate.

Obstacle Requirements (All Rounds): Obstacles must simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and the course must offer a variety of Derby jumps with different appearances such as: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs, natural foliage. Natural obstacles such as banks and ditches are allowed. A minimum 2" difference is required for the back element of an obstacle. Ground lines are not to exceed 18" in depth from the vertical plane of the jump. For appropriate jumps, no ground line is required. The jumpable portion of any obstacle must be a minimum of 8 feet on its front face. Flat cups may only be used for obstacles involving logs and/or in accordance with Federation rules.

Stabling: All horses entered in the International Hunter Derby class must be on the grounds 24 hours prior to the start of the first round in order to compete. Any horse that leaves the premises prior to completing its participation in the Derby class is disqualified.

Tie Breaking Procedures: All ties for overall first place in the class will compete in a jump-off round. In the case of unsafe conditions preventing a jump-off from being held, the tie will be broken using the second round base score (before adding height bonus points), of the designated jump-off tie breaking judging panel. Ties for other than first place in the overall standings will remain tied.

Class Specifications: Riders are limited to competing no more than four horses in each class. 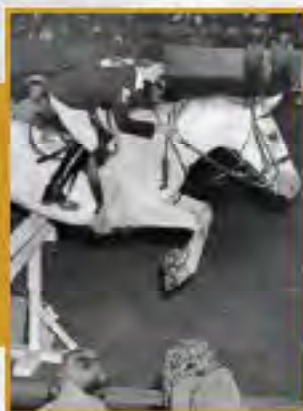

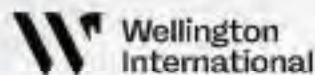

To be eligible to participate in DJS horses must: 1) Have a foaling date during 2019 for 5-Year-Old Classes, 2018 for 6-Year-Old Classes, 2017 for 7-year-old classes. 2) All USEF recorded horses MUST be age-verified by USEF prior to showing. 3) All Non USEF recorded horses must have a valid FEI or National Passport and present to the show office, valid breed registration papers issued by an approved breed registry. 4) Must be microchipped. If these conditions are not met before the class is scheduled, you will not be able to show. (NO EXCEPTIONS)

Horses competing in classes restricted to 5-year-olds may not have ever shown in Open Jumper classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money with fence heights of 1.25m or higher. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; and 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the “Federation”) and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE – GR1301.7 & .8

Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver’s license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed “unsafe use” if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

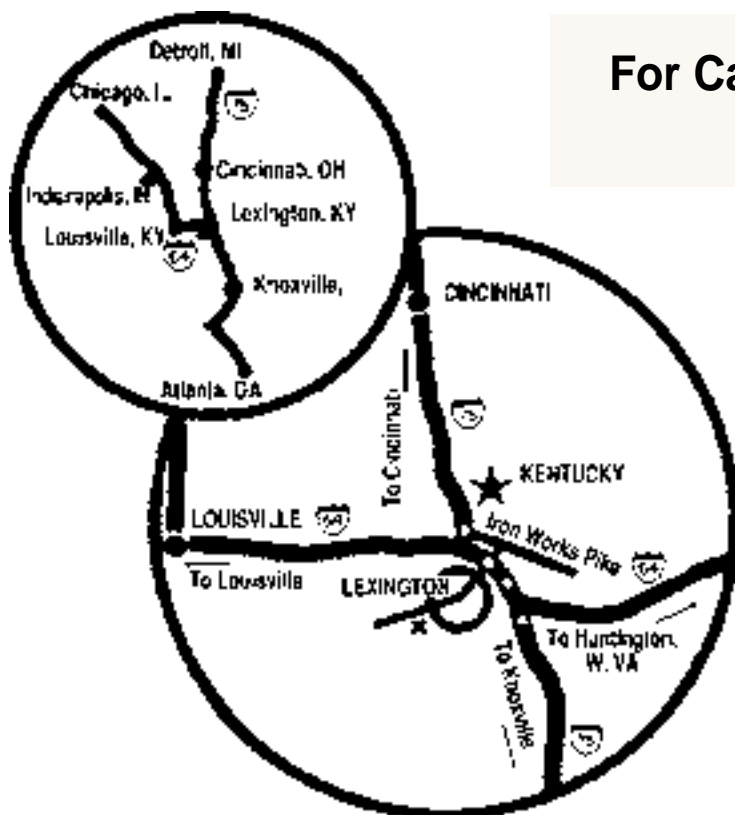
