## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Thank you for taking the time to access the online prize list for the Kentucky Summer Horse Show and the Kentucky Summer Classic, held over the two weeks beginning July 24th and ending August 4th.

Entries and stall reservations may be secured online by credit card and by mail with a check. The online entry platform is now open to accept electronic entries. Stalls will be reserved only by submission of a horse entry form and payment of a deposit in the amount of \$551.05.

USEF-Licensed competitions must operate in accordance with state and local requirements for COVID-19, if in place. In the absence of state or local requirements, USEF recommends compliance with CDC guidelines. In an effort to mitigate the risk of spreading COVID-19, Competition Organizers may impose more restrictive requirements if they so choose.

A separate USEF WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT must be completed by every exhibitor competing at the Kentucky Summer Horse Shows. Those of you using the online entry platform will be required to sign a USEF WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT as part of the entry process. ## ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE Tuesday, June 25, 2024 for the Kentucky Summer Horse Show and Kentucky Summer Classic. Post Entries will be accepted until 4:00 PM the day before the class(es) are held at regular cost plus a one time late charge of \$50.00. Class declarations will be accepted until 4:00 PM the day before the class(es) are held. Should the need arise Management reserves the right to close entries to specific class(es) before the daily 4pm deadline. All horses entered must be named on the entry blank including horses shown only in equitation where the rider is being judged.

Entries may be submitted electronically using Show Management System On-Line Entry Platform, visit [entries.showmanagementsystem.com](http://entries.showmanagementsystem.com).

A nonrefundable 3% convenience fee will be assessed for all credit card charges.

Entry blanks will be accepted **ONLY** when signed by the owner, rider or handler **AND** trainer. They must be accompanied by a check for stabling fees. Post entries will be accepted as noted above, however, **NO STALL WILL BE RESERVED UNLESS STALL FEES ARE PAID BY THE CLOSING OF ENTRIES. PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT ALL SHOWS. STALLS MAY BE RESERVED ONLY BY SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH PAYMENT. NO RESERVATIONS BY TELEPHONE. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHARGE A NON-SHOWING FEE OF \$100 TO ANY HORSE NOT ACCUMULATING ENTRY FEES OF \$100**

## STABLING

Permanent stalls are of wood construction, 10 x 12 with doors and asphalt flooring. Temporary stalls of vinyl construction with asphalt flooring, 10 x 10 with doors and under canvas are available after supply of permanent stalls has been exhausted. The cost of stalls will be \$350.00 for each show. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IN THE EVENT THE SUPPLY OF STALLS IS EXHAUSTED, PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE SHOWING AT ALL SHOWS. STALLS MAY BE RESERVED ONLY BY SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS ALONG WITH PAYMENT. STALLS MAY NOT BE RESERVED BY TELEPHONE. STALLS REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF THE KENTUCKY SUMMER HORSE SHOWS AND MAY NOT BE SOLD BY EXHIBITORS WITHOUT THE EXPRESS CONSENT OF SHOW MANAGEMENT. Early stabling (before 8:00 am Monday, July 22) or late stabling (after 8:00 am Monday, August 5) must be arranged for through the Stable Office and will be billed at \$50 per stall per day.**

**ANY STALLS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN VACATED BY 8 AM ON MONDAY, AUGUST 5 WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ASSESSED A \$50 PER DAY CHARGE BY THE KENTUCKY HORSE PARK. THIS CHARGE WILL NOT BE WAIVED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES AND WILL BE BILLED THROUGH THE SHOW OFFICE.**

**Sharps containers** will be located in the barn area. It is required to use the sharp containers for needles and disposable sharp instruments.

Any horses, whether showing or not, who do not purchase a stall will be assessed a **\$50 non stabling fee per show**. All trailers must check in at the show office and then park in the designated lot.

**NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area.**

## NIGHTWATCH

All horses occupying a stall, whether showing or not, are required to pay a one time per show nightwatch fee of \$20. This service is NOT OPTIONAL. Horses will be checked 6 times each night beginning at 7 pm on Monday, July 22 through 6:00 am Monday, August 5. Please provide emergency contact name and cell phone or hotel room and phone number at the stable office upon arrival.

## REFUNDS

**No Stall Fees or Administration Fees will be refunded after closing date of entries.** An \$85 scratch fee will be assessed on all horses scratched after the closing date of entries. Stall fees and administration fees are nonrefundable. Once the shows have started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes entered. Proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office before the start of the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above the entry fees will be refunded less stall fee (if applicable), an administration fee of \$100 and scratch fee of \$85.

## ADMINISTRATION FEE

A nonrefundable administration fee of \$100.00 per horse will be charged.

## AMBULANCE FEE

An ambulance fee of \$35 will be charged. This fee covers the cost of the medical personnel, an ambulance and the horse ambulance.

## PLEASE TAKE NOTE

- A. Horses showing in classes in which they have not previously been entered will be required to pay a double entry fee for those classes.
- B. A processing fee of \$100.00 plus collection fees will be made for any nonnegotiable checks or declined credit cards.
- C. Non-showing horses will be assessed a fee of \$100.00 per week in addition to stabling charges.
- D. A \$50.00 non stabling fee will be charged to horses, whether showing or not, which are not being billed for a stall on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park.
- E. Prize Money will be credited to each exhibitor's account. Any credit due will be mailed within 30 days following each show. No prize money will be mailed unless owner's (or other designated payee's) social security number and complete address are listed on the entry blank.

The Kentucky Summer Horse Shows, its officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. **THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWS OR SHOW GROUNDS.** Management reserves the right to change scheduled class locations or start times for any reason, inclement weather, time constraints or any other reason management decides is best for the horse's well being and competition.

## PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

Per USEF Rule GR801.2: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

## SAFE SPORT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. ## JUMP ORDER

A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

## HORSE PARK REGULATIONS

1. **PARKING** – Free parking will be provided compliments of Kentucky Horse Shows. A \$ 50.00 non stabling fee will be charged to horses, whether showing or not, which are not being billed for a stall on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park. Day trailers must park in the designated lot. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area.
2. **CAMPER'S/ R.V.'S/ HORSE TRAILERS W/LIVING SPACE** – Must go to campground.
3. **DOGS** – Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animals/animals left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
4. **HORSES AND HORSE DRAWN VEHICLES** – Have the right-of-way at all times.
5. **PACKAGES/DELIVERIES** – The Park is not responsible for any deliveries to an event or event participant. Receiving party must be present when delivery is expected. Please check with stable office for delivery address.
6. **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT**  
In compliance with the State of Kentucky Fire Code, the Kentucky Horse Park will no longer allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents. Non-complying equipment may be confiscated.
  - a) any 2 prong plug appliances (fans, etc.)
  - b) any 2 prong plug extension cords
  - c) light duty cords for indoor use
  - d) any 3-way adaptors unless specifically for outdoor use
  - e) any adaptors without 3 prong connections
7. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES**  
Only the following vehicles are approved for use on Kentucky Horse Park property: golf carts, mopeds, JD Gators, Kawasaki Mules and similar utility vehicles (NO 4-WHEELERS). Electric scooters & motorbikes & scooters with engine displacement 50 cc or less. Approved vehicles must not be operated in tourist areas of the Park & must be operated by a licensed driver at least 16 years old. All vehicles operated after dark must have a headlight & taillight. Use of unauthorized vehicles may result in a citation.
8. **GOLF CARTS**
  - a) All drivers must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license.
  - b) Golf carts are strictly prohibited in any tourist areas of the park.
  - c) Golf carts must obey all traffic laws & posted speed limits and have working headlights.
  - d) Golf carts can be rented through Dever Inc. (859) 233-9702.



## IMPORTANT EQUINE HEALTH INFORMATION

The management of the Kentucky Horse Shows would like to make the following recommendations to all exhibitors who plan to travel to the Kentucky Horse Park for any events this year.

Monitor our website at [www.kentuckyhorseshows.com](http://www.kentuckyhorseshows.com) for any additional recommendations or requirements.

1. The state of Kentucky requires that all horses entering the state provide a negative Coggins test within one year of entry as well as a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of entry. Horses originating within the state of Kentucky are required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within 150 days. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the grounds and the date of vaccination must be noted on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or documented by means noted in USEF GR845.
2. It is recommended that all horses arrive between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm. If it is absolutely necessary to arrive at any other time **you must** call the Stable Office at least 24 hours before arrival to make those arrangements. That telephone number is (503) 510-8797.
3. Please take your horse's temperature on a regular basis so as to establish a normal temperature. If that temperature is elevated prior to shipping to Kentucky please consult your veterinarian as to the advisability of shipping that horse.
4. Immediately upon arrival please take your horse's temperature and if it is elevated consult a licensed veterinarian.
5. If your regular veterinarian is coming to the Kentucky Horse Park to treat your horse(s) he or she must register at the Stable office and receive guidelines for the reporting of any suspicious occurrences.
6. Please be conscious of the need to exercise good hygiene and vigilance in the day to day care of your animals.

**To facilitate the inspection process by Kentucky Department of Agriculture personnel, this paperwork must accompany the horses upon arrival and be available throughout their stay. This paperwork must also be presented at the show office in order to pick up numbers.**

## CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS

**Campground reservations may not be made through the Horse Show office.**

To reserve a campsite at the Kentucky Horse Park for any of the horse shows, please call the Campground store at (859) 259-4257, press option 2 for camp ground or email [khpcampground@ky.gov](mailto:khpcampground@ky.gov). Be specific as to the show name and the dates you wish to stay. Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. and check-out is 12:00 noon. You must make arrangements with the Campground store if you plan to come earlier than 2:00 p.m. or stay later than 12:00 noon. Vehicles will be towed that are not removed from a campsite by check-out time.

## ALL HUNTERS

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in-and-out, oxers, post & rails, gate, aiken and panels.

All Hunter Classes are held in accordance with USEF HU118 Option A jogging for soundness: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance.

In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Trophy and eight ribbons will be presented in each hunter class unless otherwise noted.

A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for one under saddle class.

Full Championship points will be given in all classes in each hunter section, unless otherwise noted.

## JUMPER DIVISION

To be eligible for the Jumper Division, horses must be nominated and the nominating fee of \$250 paid by the closing date of entries June 25, 2024. Horses nominated after that date must pay a nominating fee of \$275. Nominated horses are eligible to compete in the Open, Amateur and Junior Jumper Sections; as well as in all Grands Prix, Jumper Classics, and special jumper classes. Non-nominated horses are only eligible for Five, Six and Seven Year Old Jumpers, Schooling, Training, Novice Junior/Amateur, Take 2 Thoroughbred, Pony, 1.0 Junior & 1.0 Amateur Jumper Sections.

Horses must be declared for the class(es) of their choice PRIOR TO THE CLOSE OF THE SHOW OFFICE or BY 4:00 PM (whichever is earlier) the day BEFORE the class(es) are held.

HORSES ENTERED IN ANY JUMPER SECTION MUST BE RECORDED WITH USEF & USHJA IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE JP101.

Champion and Reserve Champion awards will be awarded in the Young Jumper, Amateur & Junior and Pony Jumper sections. These awards will be based on points won within these sections.

Horses tied for other than first place will be placed based on their first round time, unless otherwise indicated.

If these conditions are not met before the class is scheduled, you will not be able to show. (NO EXCEPTIONS) Horses competing in classes restricted to 5-year-olds may not have ever shown in Open Jumper classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money with fence heights of 1.25m or higher. Horses competing in classes restricted to 6-year-olds may not have ever shown in Open Jumper classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money with fence heights of 1.35m or higher. Seven-year-olds may not have ever shown in Open Jumper classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money held at the National or High Performance Standard. Draw reins and standing martingales are not permitted. All Developing Jumper classes will be held in accordance with JP116. Hind Boots: Non-weighted (maximum of 350 g) hind ankle boots are permitted in classes restricted to Five- and Six-year-olds. Support wraps are permitted. If boots are made of rigid leather or plastic, they may only be a maximum of 6 inches/15 cm in height.

In accordance with GR1111.4: Canada, IA, WI, MO, TN, VA, WV, PA, NJ are contiguous states.

**JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS:** To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count. Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness. **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies. **ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:** To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

**ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:** Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections. Cross Entry: Riders entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation, Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Amateur Owner Hunter classes, and the USHJA International Hunter Derby). Riders competing in the Amateur Owner Hunter sections may compete on one different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Horses cannot cross enter into 3'3" or 3'6" Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same competition. Horses may only compete in one age group per competition. No Horse and rider combination cross entry restrictions. **Fence Height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. In and outs will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** May be split into three sections when offered by age: Adult Amateurs 18– 35 Adult Amateurs 36– 49 Adult Amateurs 50 & over. Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

**Under Saddle Classes:** If an under saddle class is divided by age and a rider has two (2) or more horses entered, all riders must be amateurs but need not be eligible by age. **Handy Hunter Classes:** Handy Hunter Classes are optional and can be added at the competition management's discretion.

**LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:** Adult Amateurs – Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Cross Entry: Riders: Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9". **Fence Height:** • 2'6" • **Low Adult Amateur Hunter Combining/Dividing Sections:** The Low Adult Amateur Hunter and Low Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in either section.

**AMATEUR JUMPER: Sections offered and requirements:** 1.00m Amateur Jumper, 1.10-1.15m Adult Amateur Jumper. **Cross Entry:** 1.00m Adult Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. Amateur Jumper riders may not cross enter into 1.40-1.45m Amateur Owner classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.30m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money (including add back money) see GR141 and JP119 for cross entry restrictions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** 1.00m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the 1.10-1.15m Amateur Jumpers at the same competition. 1.10-1.15m Amateur horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the 1.00m Amateur Jumpers at the same competition. **Fence Height:** Amateur Jumper 1.00m. Amateur Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (Junior with Amateur sections) if so stated in the prize list.

**CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE: Sections offered and requirements:** Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under. Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17 **Cross Entry:** A Children's Hunter Horse rider may only compete one different horse in the Junior Hunter Sections. Riders entered in Children's Hunter Horse sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation classes up to 3'9", Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Junior Hunter sections and USHJA International Hunter Derby). A Junior Hunter rider may only compete one different horse in the Children's Hunter Horse section. Riders entered in the Children's Hunter Horse section may only compete on one Children's Hunter Pony at the same competition. Horses entered in Children's Hunter classes may not cross enter into Junior Hunter sections at the same competition. Horses may only compete in one age group per competition. **Horse and rider combination:** No cross entry restrictions. **Fence Height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. In and outs will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. **Handy Hunter Classes:** Handy Classes are optional and can be added at the Competition Management's discretion.

**LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE: Eligibility:** Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. **Cross Entry:** Riders may not cross enter into the Pony Hunter section or any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9". **Fence Height:** • 2'6" • **Low Children's Hunter Horse Combining/Dividing Sections:** The Low Children's Hunter section and the Low Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in either section.

If a rider competing in the Children's Hunter Pony section chooses to compete in sections other than Children's Hunter Pony at the same competition, these riders are limited to competing a maximum of one (1) different pony in the Green or Regular Pony Hunter section and one (1) horse in the Children's Hunter horse section at the same competition and in any class not to exceed 3'5" (exception: Pony Jumpers). **Fence Height:** Small/Medium Ponies: 2'0" with spreads not to exceed height of fence. Large Ponies: 2'6" with spreads not to exceed height of fence. In and outs will not be permitted. Horse/Pony: No cross entry restrictions. Horse and Rider Combination: No cross entry restrictions.

**Combining/Dividing Sections:** Children's Hunter Pony sections may be combined with Children's Hunter Horse sections if there are fewer than four (4) entries in a section. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. The Children's Hunter Pony may be divided by height (small/medium and large). If there are four (4) or more entries in each height section, the sections must be held separately. Suggested Distances: At management's discretion, Children's Hunter Pony may choose to run the section as follows using the suggested distance guidelines: a. 2'0" Small Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on 9'9" stride): 4 strides at 48'9"; 5 strides at 58'6"; 6 strides at 68'3"; 7 strides at 78'8"; 8 strides at 87'9". b. 2'3" Medium Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on a 10'3" stride): 4 strides at 51'3"; 5 strides at 61'6"; 6 strides at 71'9"; 7 strides at 82'; 8 strides at 92'3". c. 2'6" Large Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on an 11' stride): 4 strides at 55'; 5 strides at 66'; 6 strides at 77'; 7 strides at 88'; 8 strides at 99'.

**JUNIOR JUMPER: Sections offered and Requirements:** 1.00-1.05 Junior Jumper. 1.10-1.15 Junior Jumper. **Cross Entry:** 1.00-1.05 Junior Jumpers riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same competition. 1.10-1.15 Junior Jumper riders may not cross enter into 1.40-1.45m Junior classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.30m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money (including add back money) see HU141 and HU137 for cross entry restrictions.

**Horse and Rider Combination:** 1.00-1.05 Junior horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the 1.10-1.15 Junior Jumpers at the same competition. 1.10-1.15 Junior horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the 1.00-1.05 Junior Jumpers at the same competition. **Fence Height:** Junior Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m. Junior Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (Junior with Amateur sections) if so stated in the prize list.

## UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION

**“Every Class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current United States Equestrian rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.”**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; and 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

### FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the “Federation”) and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

### USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE - GR1301.7 & 8

Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver’s license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed “unsafe use” if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

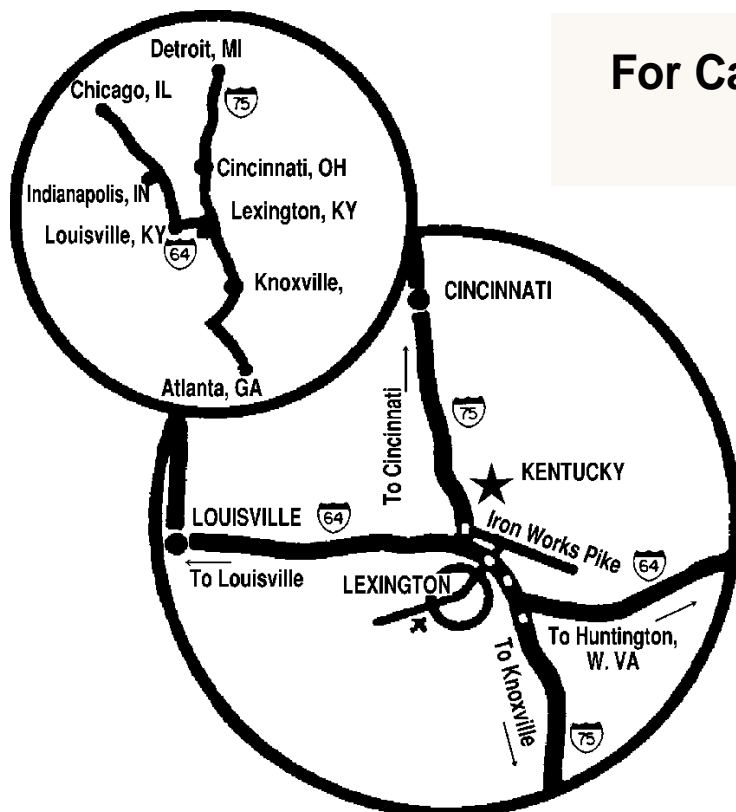
